Discussion

a. A proposal for renewing Auto, Property, and Liability Insurance was presented by Raymond Baldwin of the Baldwin Insurance Agency.

Chairman Neal asked if Commissioner Gunnels and Commissioner Grimsley were present at 6:43pm, there was no reply.

Commissioner Young made a motion to approve the renewal of Auto, Property, and Liability Insurance for County assets as presented policy by Raymond Baldwin of the Baldwin Insurance Agency. Commissioner Royal seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

At their regular meeting on July 14, 2020, the Commission agreed to accept ownership of Liberty Trace after 60% of homes are completed within the subdivision. Citizen Britt Moon was present and asked the Commission to remove the 60% completion requirement. He spoke on behalf of the developer who has agreed to have a Maintenance Bond in place for Liberty Trace.

Commissioner Young made a motion to approve accepting Liberty Trace as a County road under the conditions that the developer issues a Maintenance Bond. Commissioner Royal seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
