NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The MARION COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 2.96% unincorporated and 8.22% in the incorporated.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at 100 E Burkhalter Ave in the Marion County Commissioners conference room on December 1st at 9:00 am and 5:15 pm.

There will be an additional public hearings on this tax increase are at 100 E Burkhalter Ave in the Marion County Commissioners Conference room on December 8th at 5:15 p.m.

The tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 7.160 mills in the UNINCORPORATED and 9.320 mills in the INCORPORATED an increase of 2.96% UNINCORPORATED and 8.22% INCORPORATED. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 6.954 mills unincorporated and 8.612 mills incorporated. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$7.03 unincorporated area and \$26.50 incorp area and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$300,000 is approximately \$22.20 unincorporated and \$83.64 incorp.
